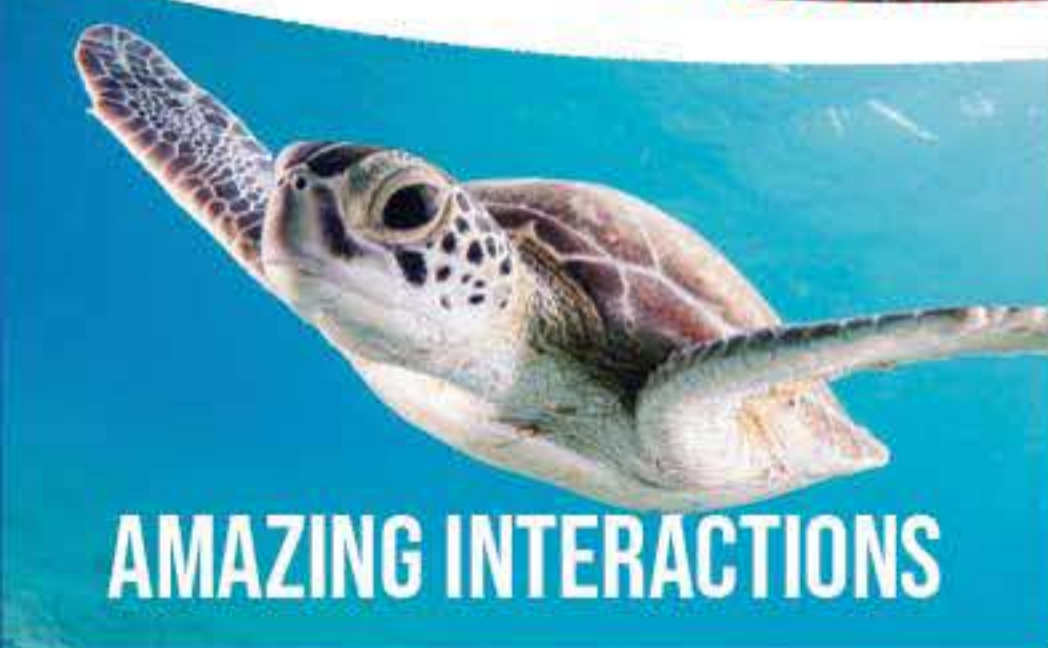

Eligibility to VETiS Certificate 3 Guarantee funding by the Queensland Government allows AGI to deliver the combined above programs which would have a normal fee in total of \$2400 for

.. **ALRIGHT!** VETiS funding criteria: Australian/ New Zealand citizen or Australian permanent resident (or on pathway to permanent residency) presently residing in Queensland and is:

- ✓ Enrolled in a Queensland school, grades 10, 11 and 12
- ✓ Not completed or presently undertaking a program from the VETiS stream funded list.

DURATION: The normal duration of this program is 6 months; however, program lengths may vary.

DELIVERY: Includes self-study (online and workbooks), face to face and practical training (skills demonstration). Delivery and assessment may include an AGI partner provider, see website for details.

Note: The Scuba license coursework is separate and is not embedded in the Certificate.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS: There are no entry requirements for this qualification, however you must complete a dive questionnaire and pending responses you may need to undertake a Scuba dive medical. During the program students will need to demonstrate the ability to swim a set distance and tread water.

WOW, FUNDING OPPORTUNITY!

Higher level skills (HLS) funding by the Queensland Government provides eligible students with a subsidy to gain higher level skills required to secure work or career advancement in priority industries, such as the shortage of skilled diving instructors in Queensland. Eligibility criteria includes:

- ✓ Queensland residents aged 15 years or over who are no longer at school (School students see Certificate II)
- ✓ Australian or New Zealand citizens, Australian permanent residents or temporary resident on the pathway to permanent residency.
- ✓ Prospective students must not hold or be enrolled in a certificate IV level or higher qualification (not including qualifications completed at school).

COURSE COST AND FEES: Course costs and fees will vary to location, please go to our website for detailed information [www.agi.edu.au] **If eligible for funding most of the training cost is covered, Wow!** Cost excludes dive agency fees such as membership, insurance and application. For instructor stream, course fee includes dive agency instructor development course but excludes instructor evaluation.

DURATION: The normal duration of this program is 12 months; however, program lengths may vary.

DELIVERY: Includes self-study (online and workbooks), face to face and practical training (skills demonstration). Delivery and assessment may include an AGI partner provider, see website for details.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS: We recommend you have some prior recreation industry experience (snorkel or dive) or qualifications.
