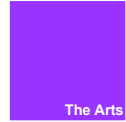

Course Outline

The Arts occupy an important role in curriculum offerings of Queensland schools. Studying any of the Arts subjects opens a myriad of opportunities for students to learn more deeply about themselves and how to connect with others. By participating in an Arts education, students build self-confidence and understand how to better express themselves. Students develop their individual strengths to enrich their lives and those around them. In Year 7 at Miami State High School, students participated in a taster course incorporating all the Arts strands. These strands lead towards elective subjects that continue right through to Year 11 and 12 General Subjects, meaning they will contribute to an ATAR score. Arts also offers Applied Subjects in each discipline. The Year 8 program offers greater depth of study in two Arts subjects studied over one semester.

- Develop collaborative work and team management skills.
- Explore your unique talents that will enrich the rest of your life.
- Develop problem solving skills through creative thinking.
