



2018 FEE SCHEDULE – STUDENT RESOURCE SCHEME

In accordance with the Education (General Provisions) Act 2006, the cost of providing instruction, administration and facilities for the education of students enrolled at State Schools who are Australian citizens or permanent residents, or children of Australian citizens of permanent residents, is met by the State.

Parents, however, are directly responsible for providing textbooks and other resources for their children while attending school. In recognition that these costs can be high, Miami State High School provides a service to assist parents with the cost of these educational resources, known as a *Student Resource Scheme* (SRS). The SRS incorporates:

Participation in the Student Resource Scheme is strongly encouraged. The scheme provides outstanding value for money as the school purchases in bulk to secure the best prices which, in turn, enables us to keep SRS fees as low as possible. In addition to the above, students who join the SRS receive a Student ID card which enables them to borrow resources from the Student Resource Centre. This scheme also provides students with subject resources (including textbooks, in-class handouts, specialist equipment and consumable materials) as outlined in the Subject Requirements List for all subjects. Should a family choose not to participate in the SRS, a list of textbooks and resources will be available on the school's website and the parent is responsible for purchasing and providing those textbooks and resources to their child whilst they are a student at Miami State High School.
