(VET) Funding in 2026!**

The Queensland Government has just announced that Year 10 students will now also be eligible to access VET funding in 2026.

This means that students in Year 10, Year 11, and Year 12 will all be able to enrol in The French's SHB20121 Certificate II in Retail Cosmetics course under this funding and kickstart their beauty career whilst still at school.

From 2026, the Certificate program has been streamlined to give students more flexibility. February starters will now complete the qualification by the end of Term 3 — a major advantage for Year 12 students heading into exam preparation, and for Year 11 students before Term 4 content begins.
