# Ready 4 Construction

## Fact Sheet • VETiS funded Certificate I in Construction (CPC10120)

**Hutchies Training delivers the CPC10120 Certificate I in Construction fee-free to eligible Queensland school students under the Vocational Education and Training in Schools (VETiS) program. Training is delivered on live Hutchies construction sites and combines hands-on learning with online study.**

**Please note** Only one VETiS funded qualification can be accessed while at school. Enrolling in this course may use your full VETiS funding entitlement.

Students can access our Student Handbook, which outlines program requirements, policies, support services, fees and refunds, privacy, feedback, complaints and appeals.

### What is?

- VETiS is a Queensland Government initiative that fully funds eligible Certificate I or II qualifications for secondary school students through approved Skills Assure Suppliers, including Hutchies Training.
- Only one VETiS funded qualification can be accessed while at school.
- By enrolling in this qualification, you may exhaust your VETiS funding entitlement.

## Qualification

Students who finish all training and assessment will earn the nationally recognised **CPC10120 Certificate I in Construction** qualification.

Students who complete some units (but not all) will receive a **Statement of Attainment**.

## Costs and requirements

- No co-contribution fees for **eligible** VETiS students
- Students must buy steel cap boots and work-ready shorts or pants
- Hutchies provides site shirt and hi-vis PPE
- If VETiS funding has been used, the full fee to complete the qualification is **\$3,500** (for 11 units of competency)

## Eligibility

To enrol, you must:

- Be in Year 11 or 12 at a Queensland secondary school for the whole program
- Not an international exchange student
- Not have completed a VETiS-funded Certificate I or II before
- Show a genuine interest in a construction career after school

## Learning format

- Training delivered on a live construction site
- Mix of face-to-face and online learning
- Practical assessments completed on site or in workshop spaces
- Theory assessments completed online through our Learning Management System (LMS)
- Laptops or tablets available at campus
- No vocational placement needed – all training is done on site

This year our Ready 4 Construction program on the Gold Coast will look a bit different. Training occurs on live construction sites which therefore means that they are subject to the programming on the site. Currently we do not have a construction site that can accommodate us.

Rather than not provide the opportunity of the program to Gold Coast students until we find a suitable venue, we have created a pilot program for this year. We will be predominately based at our Southport office, where students will be able to complete their theory and some practical activities. They will be able to see firsthand other non-trade construction roles, Contract Administrators, Project Manager etc, whilst in the office, plus we will organise site visits and activities throughout the course, so they will continue to see the trade roles too.

The different locations will be pre-organised and communicated so the students will know where they need to be each week. We hope that the added exposure to the non-trade career paths will outweigh the extra flexibility required.
