INSTRUCTIONAL FLIGHT

The Honourable Company of Air Pilots (Queensland Working Group) have, once again, generously opened applications for Trial Instructional Flights (TIF) Awards exclusively to Aerospace Gateway Schools students.

What is it?

A trial instructional flight is normally a 30-45 minute flight with a flight instructor who will show you the basic features of an aircraft and allow you to take control. This is a great way for future pilots to experience what it is like to fly.

This year HCAPS (QWG) will award up to nine TIFs, to be taken within six months, at a CASA approved flight school located anywhere in Queensland of your school's choice [valued up to \$300 each].

Who can apply?

Applicants must be:

- 16 years old (or over) by the time they take their flight.
- Enrolled in an aerospace gateway school.
- Are NOT required to be studying an aerospace subject.
- Applications must be endorsed by a teacher and your Principal to be eligible.

Applications close 30 June 2024.

In addition to the TIF awards offered, HCAPS have a number of pilot scholarships, at a variety of experience levels, that are currently available and open publicly. Applications close 24 May 2024. Minimum requirements and application details for each scholarship can be found on their website.

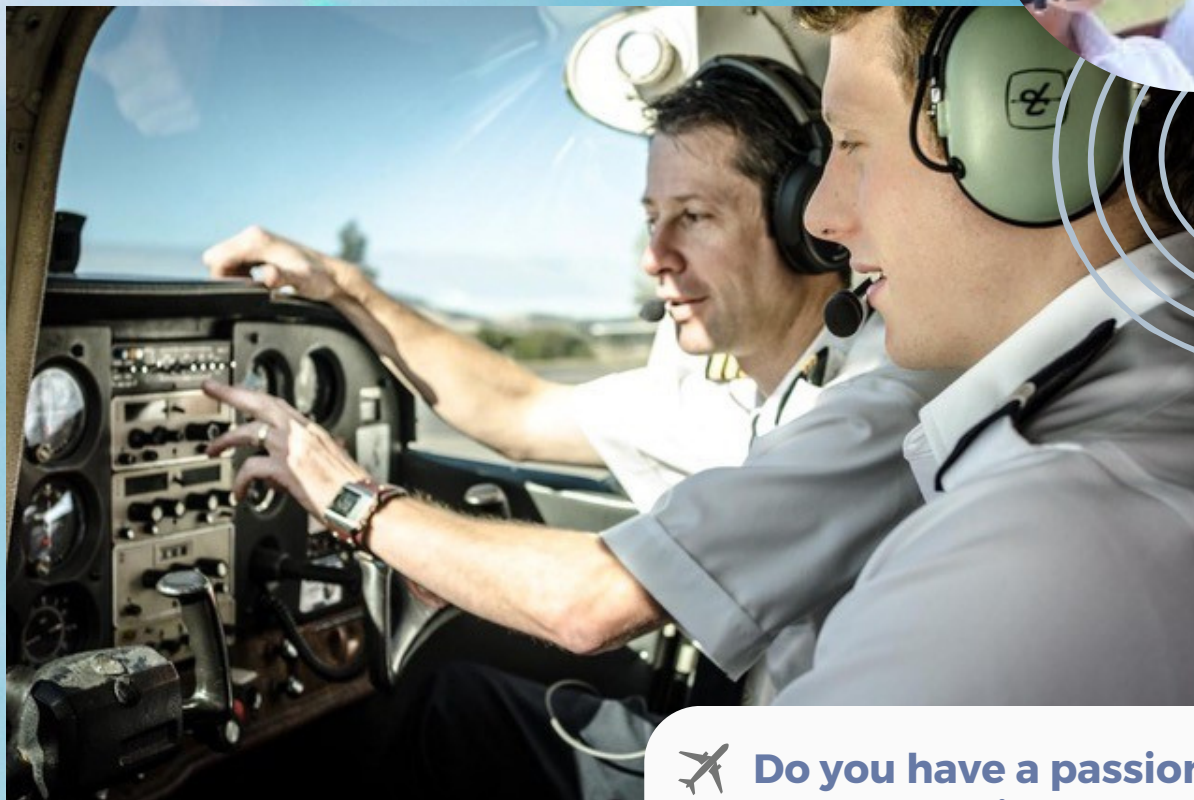

TRIAL INTRODUCTORY FLIGHT SCHOLARSHIPS CONDITIONS OF ENTRY 2024

1. This document outlines the Terms and Conditions for awards sponsored by the Honourable Company of Air Pilots, Australia Inc (HCAPA).
2. A parent or guardian must read these Terms and Conditions in full and consent on behalf of the student receiving the award.
3. HCAPA will offer up to nine awards for the successful applicants to undertake a Fixed Wing Trial Introductory Flight (TIF) up to the value of \$300. Those awarded the TIF will have six months to complete the flight from the date of notification to the successful student.
4. The awarded school's representative, in consultation with the student's parent/guardian, will decide which Flight School their successful candidate will engage for their TIF. The Flight School must be a CASA approved School.
5. Award applications are open to students enrolled at participating Aerospace Gateway Schools in Queensland.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

6. To qualify for the sponsorship, students will:
 - a. Write an essay not more than 500 words as to why they believe a Fixed Wing Trial Instructional Flight will benefit their desire to become a pilot.
 - b. Have no previous flying training experience.
 - c. Be at least 16 years of age, at the time of redeeming the TIF.
 - d. Be enrolled at an Aerospace Gateway to Industry School.
 - e. Provide a written recommendation from the School Head of the Aerospace subject curriculum.
7. HCAPA's Queensland Working Group, in liaison with the Aerospace Gateway to Industry Schools Project team, will review applications and decide who is awarded each award. Their decision is final and no appeal will be entertained.

AWARD PAYMENT

8. A maximum payment of \$300 each will be transferred to the nominated Flight School of each successful candidate.
9. Once the TIF has been booked, the nominated Flight School will send the invoice directly to the HCAPA's Regional Treasurer (details to be advised) to arrange an electronic transfer to the nominated bank account
10. Awards will be granted to students only. School employees, parents, guardians and Aerospace Gateway School representatives are not eligible to apply.
11. The winners of the awards will be notified in writing. 2024 winners will be notified no later than 10 December 2024.
12. The value of the award is not transferable or redeemable and only valid for a Fixed Wing TIF.
13. HCAPA's, Aerospace Gateway to Industry Schools Project and its employees and/or members, accept no responsibility or liability for any act or incident that occurs in connection with this award which results from or is caused by any act or omission of the organisers or any other person.
