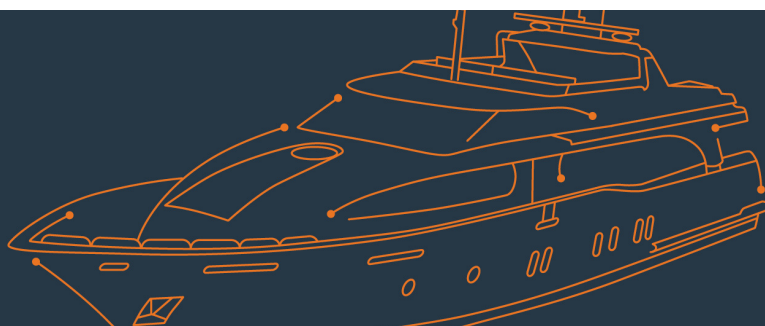

- Students with an interest in STEAM subjects (Science, Technologies, Engineering, Arts & Maths)

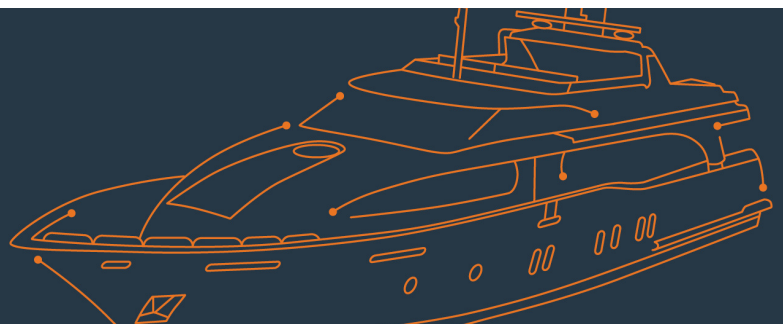
WHAT DOES IT INVOLVE?
